The BC Hear the Child Society requires **all** Roster members to be a member in good standing of the BC Hear the Child Society and:

1. Membership

- A) ☐ be a member in good standing of the Law Society of BC; OR
- B) ☐ be a member in good standing of a mental health profession in BC with standards of professional conduct and ethics, and a disciplinary process:
- ☐ College of Psychologists of BC (RPsych)
